ARCHERY

TIMES OFFERED: 9, 11 am, 3, 4 pm

LOCATION: Archery Range

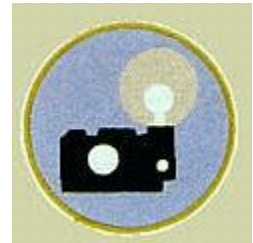
