

Instructions and Explanation for the Summer Express 2011 Enrollment Form

We are attending Boy Scout summer resident camp at Camp Geiger. Camp Geiger is owned and operated by the Pony Express Council, Saint Joseph, Missouri.

The Pony Express Council partners with the Saint Joseph School District. The local school district receives government funding essentially counting the scout summer sessions as summer school sessions. They share that revenue with the council.

To receive that funding the Pony Express Council must document each scout's attendance with the attached form. It changes a little each year and this year requires the signature of a parent or guardian. Therefore the form cannot be completed at camp. **They are asking that they be completed before camp and turned in when we check into camp Sunday afternoon (or Monday morning in the case of LDS units).**

The revenue that the Pony Express Council receives is considerable amounting to about \$20 for every form we turn in. It helps the council keep their camp fees lower than they would otherwise be. So it is in our interest also to cooperate with this request.

Some FAQs:

1. My son does not live in the Saint Joseph School District. Does this apply to us? Yes, the council will receive their revenue for every scout that attends summer camp whether from Missouri, Wyoming, Texas or wherever.
2. My son is home schooled. Does this apply to us? Yes, the council will receive their revenue as if he attended a summer school session. Write "Home School" in the Name of School blank.
